Information on REACH Regulation No. 1907/2006 and Regulation (EU) 2023/1064 Amending Annex XVII

Dear Sir or Madam,

For substances of very high concern (SVHC), there is an obligation to communicate information in accordance with Article 33. A list of these substances is available on the website of the [European Chemicals Agency \(ECHA\)](https://echa.europa.eu/).

Our products currently do not contain any substances of very high concern in a concentration of more than 0.1 percent. Should any product supplied to you in the future contain a substance that has been newly added to the SVHC list in a concentration exceeding 0.1 percent by mass, we will inform you accordingly without further request.

New formaldehyde limit values effective from 6 August 2026

From 6 August 2026, a limit value of 0.062 mg/m³ will apply to furniture and articles based on wood-based materials. Exempted, among others, are products in which formaldehyde and formaldehyde releasing substances occur naturally in the materials from which the articles are manufactured. As a result, non-bonded solid wood products and products manufactured using formaldehyde-free adhesives do not fall under the formaldehyde requirements.

Binderholz solid wood products bonded with formaldehyde-containing adhesives comply with the limit value of 0.062 mg/m³ as stipulated by the REACH Regulation. The specific results of the independently conducted emission tests cannot be included in the declaration of performance, as the relevant harmonised product standards provide for a formal declaration in formaldehyde classes (e.g. E1).
